

NEW WEST CHARTER – OUTREACH REPORT 2016-2017

This outreach report contains demographic information about pupils who attended our open houses (Table A), and new pupils enrolled in the school for the 2015-2016 school year (Table B).

The data from the outreach surveys was optional and does not reflect all the pupils who attended the open houses or all the pupils who applied.

The enrollment data shows a significant increase for the Hispanic and Latino category due to our outreach efforts with Brockton Elementary and their preference in the lottery.

There is also a significant increase for the Socio-Economically Disadvantaged category due to our outreach efforts at schools with a high percentage of low-income students, and due to the lottery preference for low-income students.

Table C is a table of the school breakdown of all the pupils who applied for 2016-2017 school year. This table shows that students interested in coming to New West Charter are coming from over 140 different schools.
